

## Year 11

### Exam Week Briefing w/c 03/06/19

Year 11 have responded exceptionally well once again this week where a number of very significant exams have been taken. Students have been well organised and almost all students have taken part in revision booster sessions and exam preparation sessions. Lessons will continue as normal when students do not have examinations.

Parents can continue to help at home by ensuring that students continue with revision and that students eat well, keep hydrated and sleep well in the week ahead.
