

FACE MASKS IN SCHOOL – Rules for Students

You must bring two masks to school with you each day. If you are unable to wear a mask because of medical reasons you must bring and wear your lanyard.

The design and type of mask cannot be offensive in any way. The school's decision on this matter is final.

You must put your mask on when you enter the school building at the beginning of the day.
This will be checked by your Head of Year or Deputy Head of Year at the door to your zone.
You will not be allowed into school if you are not wearing a mask.

If you have lost or forgotten both your masks your Year Team will provide one at the door.
You will be charged 50p per mask.

If a member of staff has concerns that you have taken your mask off or are not wearing properly, they will contact your Year Team and it will be investigated using CCTV.



You must wear your mask when:

- You move to your first lesson.
- You move between lessons, no matter how short the distance may be.
- You leave the building for break/lunch, no matter how short the distance may be.
(Unless you are using an outside door that leads into the playground)
- You re-enter the school building to use the toilet at break/lunch.
- You leave the building at the end of the day, no matter how short the distance may be.
(Unless you are using an outside door that leads into the playground)

This will be checked by your Year Team and SLT.



Once you have sat in your seating plan you may remove your mask if you wish.

If you lose both your masks during a lesson tell your teacher at an appropriate time. If you lose both your masks at break/lunch tell the duty staff.

At the end of your lesson your teacher will check that you are wearing a mask before you leave the room.
