Autumn Term Re-Sit Opportunities

This week, we have been informed of the Government's plans to offer re-sit opportunities to students who are not satisfied with the Government awarded grade that will be issued to you in August.

We have been told that an autumn series of exams will run as follows for those students who wish to re-sit:

- **AS and A-level exams:** from Monday 5th October to Friday 23rd October
- **GCSE exams:** from Monday 2nd November to Monday 23rd November.

You'll be able to start making entries after your results days. In the meantime, the **entry deadlines** for these exams are:

- AS and A-level – 2nd September
- GCSE (except English Language and Mathematics) – 16th September
- GCSE (English Language and Mathematics) – 30th September

Nearer the time, you will find a link in the 'Exams' section of our website where you will be able to notify us of your wish to re-sit by completing an electronic form after you have received your results.

We will use this section of our website to keep you up-to-date with the latest news on this as we receive it.

Just to remind you again that the results days are as follows:

Level 3/BTEC/A-Level exams: Thursday 13th August - time tbc
Level 2/V-Cert/BTEC/GCSE exams: Thursday 20th August – time tbc
