Mobile Devices Policy

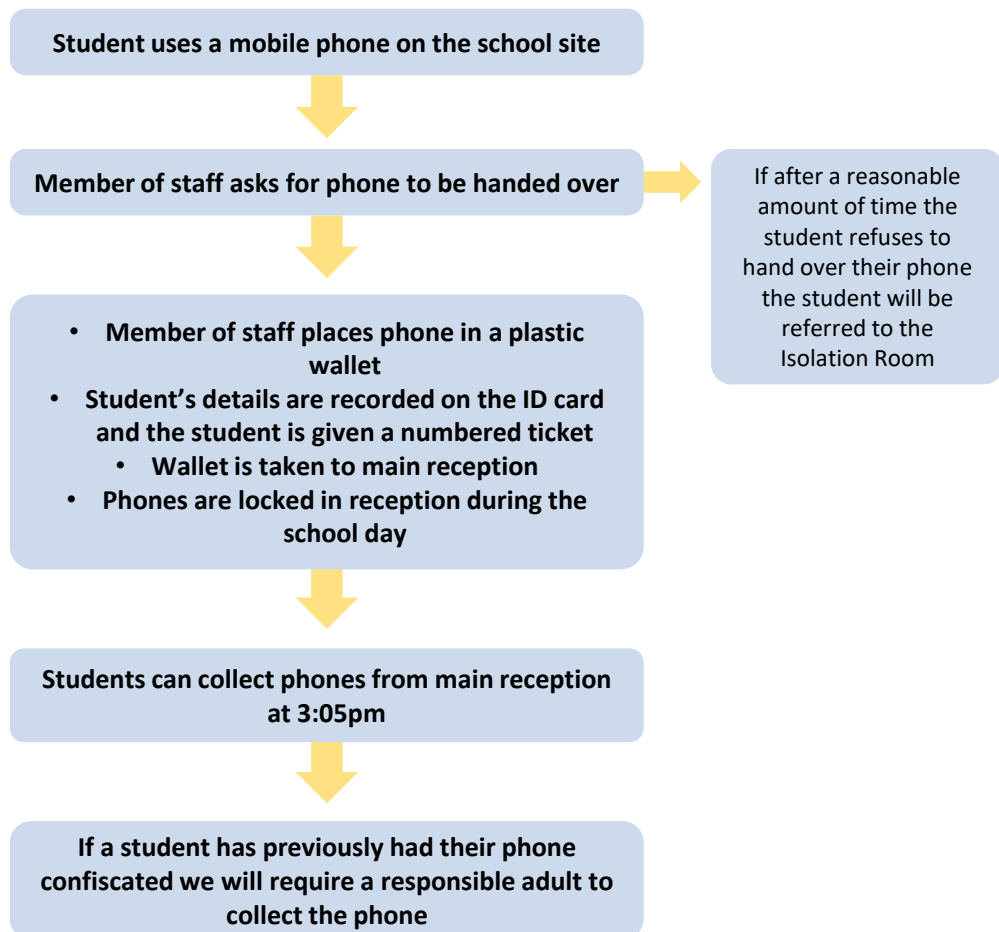
September 2019 onwards

This policy applies to phones, tablets, iPads, headphones and all other mobile devices.

Mobile phones should be switched off and in bags when students enter the school site in the morning. If phones are seen they will be confiscated (see flowchart below). Students can use their phones after they are dismissed by their last teacher.

This information has been explained to students in assemblies delivered by the Vice Principal and Assistant Principal and has also been communicated directly to parents.

We will always offer students access to a school phone if they need to urgently contact a parent/carer.



If a student uses their phone as a bus ticket or has a long walk home it is their responsibility to ensure the phone remains switched off and in their bag at all times.

We will always ensure that students are given the appropriate pass, ticket or alternative to secure their bus journey home.
