What will I study?

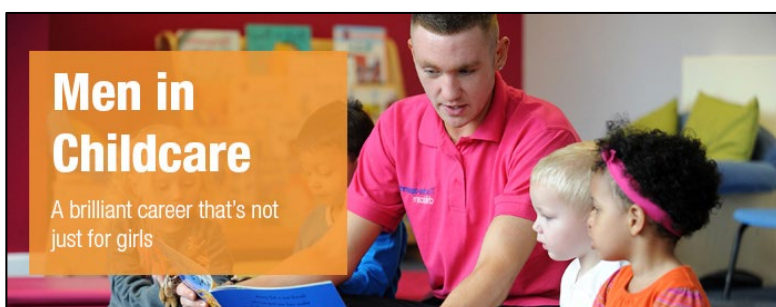
- 1) **Principles of Working in Health, Social Care and Childcare** (Examination)
