



SBL SIXTH FORM: COURSE INFORMATION

ACCESS TO LEVEL 3

This programme is designed for students who would like to study at level 3 (Apprenticeships, BTEC, A Levels) but have not yet met the requirements of five grades 9-4 including English or Maths.

This is a one year programme where you will be able to achieve equivalent to five grade 4s at GCSE. Students will normally have achieved five or more grade 3 GCSEs in year 11 to take this course.

After the year, most students will continue studying a SBL Sixth Form for a further two years, taking A levels or Level 3 vocational courses. However, many students will progress to the world of work via an apprenticeship or training programme at level 3.
